Starting wage for Full Time is \$26.33 per hour with step increases up to \$29.68 after 1-year successful employment with an additional .50 per hour for late shift. Starting wage for Part-time (day or late shift) is \$23.98 per hour. Crawford County offers competitive wage increases and an excellent benefits package. **Minimum Qualifications:** Employees must be a U.S. Citizen – at least 18 years of age – high school diploma or equivalent - have a valid driver's license with a good driving record – no felony convictions or convictions of domestic violence laws – good character as established by a thorough background investigation - must successfully complete a timed skills, aptitude and personality test, drug screen, and a one-year probationary period.
