- Communicate with the landlord before and after the application is submitted
- 4. **Complete** the application fully even if you are unsure. Some landlords will automatically deny an incomplete application. Most Landlords want at least 5 Years Rental History to Verify.
- 5. Have supporting documents and letters ready to show
  - a. Paystubs, 2<sup>nd</sup> chance letter, recommendation letters, bank statements, etc

All these tips will help the landlord process applications quicker and easier. landlords often receive multiple applications for a rental, so you want to do everything to stand out and have the best chances of getting approved.
