

Tips to Filling Out a Rental Application

1. **Preparation is key-** know accurate information for everyone in your household to make the process easier - use tools in Rent Ready Folder.
2. **Be honest!** Landlords will find out information on background and credit checks. Checking CCAP is a good way to know what others can see

3. **Communicate** with the landlord before and after the application is submitted
4. **Complete** the application fully even if you are unsure. Some landlords will automatically deny an incomplete application. Most Landlords want at least 5 Years Rental History to Verify.
5. Have **supporting documents** and letters ready to show
 - a. Paystubs, 2nd chance letter, recommendation letters, bank statements, etc

All these tips will help the landlord process applications quicker and easier. landlords often receive multiple applications for a rental, so you want to do everything to stand out and have the best chances of getting approved.
