

Crawford County has developed an educational program, which focuses on the risks associated with tobacco and vape use and how to lower those risks.

The purpose of this program is to give you, the underage offender, an alternative. It is designed to offer you an opportunity to take a hard look at your behavior in terms of tobacco and vape usage.

You have been issued a citation for a tobacco-related violation. (Wisc. Stats.) and <u>are required to appear in court</u> on the date shown on your citation. <u>For offenders 16 & under, court appearances by the parent is also required.</u>

#### About the Program:

Healthy Futures is a 4 hour curriculum created by the Tobacco Prevention Toolkit team at Stanford University School of Medicine as a response for the need to prevent further use of tobacco/nicotine products in youth. The curriculum covers health effects of vaping, understanding addiction, social media targeting, and the expense of vaping. This program also allows for personal reflection and group discussion following each topic.

#### Goals:

\*To understand basic information about tobacco products, including ecigarettes/vape pens & the harm they cause.

\*To gain awareness of strategies maufactuters of tobacco, employ to increase use among adolescents through deceptive and creative marketing strategies.

\*To gain skills to refuse experimentation and use of tobacco.

Alternative Program for Underage Tobacco/Vape Use & Possession

#### PENALTY GUIDELINES FOR AGES: 12 & 13:

#### $\rightarrow$ 1<sup>ST</sup> OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$143.80 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS) \$175.30 (ON SCHOOL GROUNDS) & 20 HRS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE.

#### → 1<sup>ST</sup> OFFENSE ALTERNATIVE:

"HEALTHY FUTURES" FOR ME; PARENT-TO-PARENT PROGRAM FOR PARENT(S).

#### $\rightarrow$ 2<sup>ND</sup> OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$175.30 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS) \$200.50 (ON SCHOOL GROUNDS) & 30 HRS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK.

#### $\rightarrow$ 2<sup>ND</sup> OFFENSE ALTERNATIVE:

"HEALTHY FUTURES" & PARENT-TO-PARENT-PROGRAM (IF NOT PREVEIOUSLY COMPLETED), 30 HRS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK.

#### $\rightarrow$ 3<sup>RD</sup> OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$200.50 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS) \$263.50 (ON SCHOOL GROUNDS) AND 40 HRS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK.

## If I choose to Particiapte in "Healthy Futures Program,"

#### I MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:

- Fill out the registratinon form, pay
  the \$ fee, attend <u>all</u> the class
  sessions, be on time, and actively
  participate, pass the tests, and
  complete all assignments.
- If I am age 16 or under, my parent(s) or legal guardian must also complete the Positive Parenting Program.

### PENALTY GUIDELINES FOR AGES:

14, 15, 16, & 17:

#### → 1<sup>ST</sup> OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$175.30 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS) or \$200.50 (ON SCHOOL GROUNDS). 60-DAY DRIVER'S LICENSE SUSPENSION.

#### → 1st OFFENSE ALTERNATIVE:

"HEALTHY FUTURES" PROGRAM & POSITIVE PARENTING PROGRAM (TRIPLE P)

#### $\rightarrow$ 2<sup>ND</sup> OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$200.50 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS) \$263.50 (ON SCHOOL GROUNDS). 120-DAY LICENSE SUSPENSION.

#### → 2<sup>ND</sup> OFFENSE ALTERNATIVE:

"HEALTHY FUTURES" & PARENT-TO-PARENT PROGRAM (IF NOT PREVIOUSLY COMPLETED), 30-DAY LICENSE SUSPENSION.

#### $\rightarrow$ 3<sup>RD</sup> OFFENSE:

FORFEIT 326.50 & 1 YEAR DRIVER'S LICENSE SUSPENSION.
