



Crawford County has developed an educational program, which focuses on the risks associated with tobacco and vape use and how to lower those risks.

The purpose of this program is to give you, the underage offender, an alternative. It is designed to offer you an opportunity to take a hard look at your behavior in terms of tobacco and vape usage.

You have been issued a citation for a tobacco-related violation. (Wisc. Stats.) and **are required to appear in court** on the date shown on your citation. **For offenders 16 & under, court appearances by the parent is also required.**

About the Program:

Healthy Futures is a 4 hour curriculum created by the Tobacco Prevention Toolkit team at Stanford University School of Medicine as a response for the need to prevent further use of tobacco/nicotine products in youth. The curriculum covers health effects of vaping, understanding addiction, social media targeting, and the expense of vaping. This program also allows for personal reflection and group discussion following each topic.

Goals:

*To understand basic information about tobacco products, including e-cigarettes/vape pens & the harm they cause.

*To gain awareness of strategies manufacturers of tobacco, employ to increase use among adolescents through deceptive and creative marketing strategies.

*To gain skills to refuse experimentation and use of tobacco.

PENALTY GUIDELINES FOR AGES: 12 & 13:

→ 1ST OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$143.80 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS) \$175.30
(ON SCHOOL GROUNDS) & 20 HRS OF COMMUNITY
SERVICE.

→ 1ST OFFENSE ALTERNATIVE:

"HEALTHY FUTURES" FOR ME; PARENT-TO-
PARENT PROGRAM FOR PARENT(S).

→ 2ND OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$175.30 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS) \$200.50
(ON SCHOOL GROUNDS) & 30 HRS OF COMMUNITY
SERVICE WORK.

→ 2ND OFFENSE ALTERNATIVE:

"HEALTHY FUTURES" & PARENT-TO-
PARENT-PROGRAM (IF NOT PREVIOUSLY
COMPLETED), 30 HRS OF COMMUNITY
SERVICE WORK.

→ 3RD OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$200.50 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS) \$263.50
(ON SCHOOL GROUNDS) AND 40 HRS OF
COMMUNITY SERVICE WORK.

If I choose to Participate in "Healthy Futures Program,"

I MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:

- Fill out the registration form, pay the \$ fee, attend all the class sessions, be on time, and actively participate, pass the tests, and complete all assignments.
- If I am age 16 or under, my parent(s) or legal guardian must also complete the Positive Parenting Program.

PENALTY GUIDELINES FOR AGES: 14, 15, 16, & 17:

→ 1ST OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$175.30 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS)
or \$200.50 (ON SCHOOL GROUNDS). 60-DAY
DRIVER'S LICENSE SUSPENSION.

→ 1st OFFENSE ALTERNATIVE:

"HEALTHY FUTURES" PROGRAM &
POSITIVE PARENTING PROGRAM
(TRIPLE P)

→ 2ND OFFENSE:

FORFEIT \$200.50 (OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS)
\$263.50 (ON SCHOOL GROUNDS). 120-DAY
LICENSE SUSPENSION.

→ 2ND OFFENSE ALTERNATIVE:

"HEALTHY FUTURES" & PARENT-TO-
PARENT PROGRAM (IF NOT PREVIOUSLY
COMPLETED), 30-DAY LICENSE
SUSPENSION.

→ 3RD OFFENSE:

FORFEIT 326.50 & 1 YEAR DRIVER'S
LICENSE SUSPENSION.
